



Seeking Veterans to Give their Opinions on a New Mobile App

Purpose: A team at the Department of Veterans Affairs has designed a self-help mobile app to support the health and well-being of survivors of sexual assault or harassment during military service, also called military sexual trauma (MST). The purpose of this interview is to get opinions and feedback about the new app from MST survivors as they are experiencing using it for the first time.

Would the interview be a good fit for me? The interview may be a good fit for you if:

- You are a Veteran that had unwanted sexual experiences during your military service, sometimes called MST or military sexual trauma
- You have a mobile device or tablet
- You are 18 years or older
- You speak English

Where will the interview take place? This interview will take place using a secure, private video conferencing platform. You can participate from any quiet location at a time that you choose.

Participants who take part in this interview will receive a \$100 Amazon.com gift card to thank them for their time.

We are seeking opinions from Veterans of all genders, all races, all ethnicities, all eras of service, all ages, and all stages of recovery.

What will happen if I choose to do the interview? If you decide to do this interview, you would participate in a video conferencing call for about 75 minutes. You would be asked to share your opinions on the mobile app. We will **not** ask you to provide any information about your MST experiences.
